



Requirements for Hostel

The students are hereby informed that the following facilities will be provided in the Hostels (Boys & Girls):

1. Cot (measuring 6.5'X3')
2. Study Table
3. Chair
4. Cupboard (sharing basis)

The students are required to arrange for the following on their own (will not be provided by the college)

1. Mattress (measuring not more than 6'X3')
2. Pillow, Pillow covers, Sheets & **Blanket**.
3. Bucket, Mugs
4. Rain-coat, Umbrella
5. Toiletries (Tooth-paste, Tooth-brush, Soap, Detergent, Shampoo)
6. Clothing (**warm clothing advised**)
7. Utensils for personal use (plate, spoon, glass, and water-bottle)

This list is not exhaustive. Hostel inmates may consider additions or deletions as per their requirement as long as the hostel rules are not violated.

Note

1. Consumption of alcohol & smoking is strictly prohibited in the hostel.
2. Any violation of hostel rules will result in expulsion of the student without notice.
3. Ragging is a serious criminal offense. Any student involved in the same will be expelled from the hostel without prior notice.
4. Students are strictly instructed, not to use Electric Geysers fitted in the rooms until instructed to do so.
5. Affidavit to Warden if not given already
6. Caution deposit of Rs 10,000.00 and Annual room rent of Rs 9000.00 has to be paid if not paid already
7. The students are instructed to carry with them the following at the time of Hostel room allotment:
 - a) Copy of receipt for having paid the hostel fees
 - b) Valid Id proof

1. Dissection set: scalpel handle with blade, pointed forceps(6" long), blunt forceps(6" long), toothed forceps(6" long) and steel scissor (1 each)
2. Haematoxylin and Eosin (H & E) – Pencils
3. One Bone Set (Information to procure the same will be provided to the students only on the day of orientation). This may be purchased after joining the college.
4. Transparent Pouch to keep the stationaries (as per exam guidelines)

3. Pen Torch (Non LED)
4. Tuning Forks (128Hz & 512Hz)
5. Lancets
6. Measuring tape
